1 Zusammenfassung (Management Summary)

Gemäss seiner Strategie startete das Department Public Health das Projekt INSPIRE (Implementation of an Integrated Community-based Care Program for Senior Citizens) in Basel Landschaft mit allen DPH-Partnern.

DPH baute die Pilotstudie für eine schweizweite Gesundheitskohorte und Biobank von 100.000 Bürgern als Grundlage für Biomonitoring und personalisierte Gesundheit auf (Swiss TPH & ISPM, UNIL). Zudem wurde eine schweizweite Studie bei Hausärzten zur Demenzversorgung (uniham-bb) durchgeführt.

Erfolgreiche DPH-Finanzierungen (z. B. NFP, SAMW, SNF, Schweizerische Krebsliga) und bedeutsame Publikationen zeigen die starke Forschungsaktivität in 2017.

Es wurden 5 Venia Docendi (Habilitationen) vergeben.

Prof. Regina Kunz (EbIM) erhielt den Titel "Highly Cited Researcher" (Thomson Reuters as one of two scientists at UNIBAS).

Prof. Marcel Tanner hielt seinen Abschlussvortrag "no roots - no fruits". Wir danken ihm von Herzen, dass er als Kollege der Weiterentwicklung des DPH treu bleibt.
